Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Admittedly, petitioner no.2-Priyanka is minor whereas petitioner no.1-Mohan is stated to be more than 21 years of age.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in order to protect the life and liberty of petitioner no.2, a representation dated 13.09.2018 has already been made to the Superintendent of Police, Karnal, respondent no.2.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, but confining the prayer made for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner no.2-Priyanka, the present petition is disposed with a direction to respondent no.2-Superintendent of Police, Karnal to take appropriate remedial measures on the representation dated 13.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law and ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner no.2-Priyanka. The direction is restricted only for the relief of protection of life and liberty of the petitioner no.2.

Similarly, in case petitioner no.1 also submits a representation for protection of his life and liberty before respondent no.2 within a week from today, the same shall be acted upon in accordance with law.
