Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner having been summoned on an application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C., he appeared before the trial Court on 18.12.2017 and has been admitted to *ad interim* anticipatory bail, in terms of the order of this Court dated 13.12.2017.

Though, vide that order, the petitioner had been directed to join investigation and fully co-operate with the investigating/arresting officer, however, it obviously was missed out that in fact the petitioner had already been declared innocent by the investigating agency and therefore was not required to join investigation, unless so ordered by the trial Court, and instead was required to appear before the said Court.

Consequently, the petitioner having appeared before the trial Court, the order passed by that Court on 18.12.2017 is made absolute, granting bail to the petitioner, subject to his continuing to appear before the trial Court as and when summoned.

The petition is disposed of, accordingly.
