The petitioner is feeling threatened at the hand of respondents No.4 to 9. He apprehends that they hatched a conspiracy to eliminate him in order to grab his property. A representation dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-2) has been submitted in this regard to respondent No.2 but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Jasdeep Singh Walia, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No.4 to 9.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to objectively consider the representation dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-2) and in case, it is found necessary to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
