This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.110 dated 25.9.2016 under section 379 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Kartarpur, District Jalandhar (Rural)

On 2.11.2017, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the allegations against the petitioner are cutting of trees and the matter is primarily of civil nature. He further contended that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Adjourned to 19.1.2018.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall join investigation as and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Satpal Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

In the considered view of this Court, custodial interrogation of the petitioner, as such, would not be warranted. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 2.11.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
