Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.62 dated 17.02.2017, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Faridabad, under Sections 420, 406, 465, 467, 468, 469, 471, 475 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the allegations in the FIR, Sumer Singh, brother of the present petitioner, who was working as a Sales Officer in Shri Ram

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Life Insurance Company Ltd., had forged seven proposals of dead persons for the purpose of claiming insurance. The allegation against the present petitioner is that he has been shown as nominee in one of the aforesaid policies.

The petitioner has been in custody since 06.06.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
