Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.41 dated 14.07.2018 under Sections 307, 395, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

On the previous occasion, this Court passed the following order:-

“In the present petition, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.41 dated 14.07.2018 under Sections 307, 395, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Perusal of the FIR it is evident that there is no specific role of the petitioner is attributed in respect of causing injuries. Moreover, petitioner is not involved in any other case. Hence petitioner is entitled to anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion for 22.11.2018.

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Petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation.

In the event of his appearance, Investigating Officer shall release him on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to his entire satisfaction. He shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C .

However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair investigation.”

Today learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Paramjit has stated that in terms of the order of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation, recovery is already effected and his custody is no more required.

In view of the above, the order dated 26.09.2018 is made absolute and the petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the trial Court during pendency of the case.
