ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.24 dated 06.03.2018, registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 498-A, 34 of IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), at Police Station Khamanon, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 07.08.2018 and there is no injury under Section 307 IPC against and the injury is alleged to have been caused by him with a sharp edged object.

Learned State counsel had produced the MLR. The dimension of the injury has been seen. Counsel further states that challan has already been prepared but has not been filed yet.

The record reveals that earlier the mother-in-law had filed a complaint against the daughter-in-law. The dispute between them is going on since the last week of February, 2018.

Investigation is already over. The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
