In terms of order passed by this Court on 27.11.2018, reply by way of affidavit of Gajender Kumar, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, NIIT, Faridabad, on behalf of State of Haryana, has already been filed.

Heard. It is alleged that some fake items of Loreal Paris, Maybelline, Newyork, were recovered from shop of petitioner. The recovery of all these fake items made. However, the police has not gone into depth of matter by finding out man who was supplying these fake items.

According to learned State counsel, these fake items were purchased by petitioner from Delhi, but he is not disclosing name and address of person from whom he purchased these fake items.

I am of the view that selling of fake items is a serious matter. The kingpin of entire crime is yet to be nabbed. Therefore, there is no ground to grant anticipatory bail to petitioner. Petition is dismissed.
