The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 25.8.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 436, 427, 148, 149, 120-B, 188 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") and read with Section 3/4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 and Sections 3 and 4 of Explosive Substances Act, 1908 at Police Station Jaurkian, District Mansa, Punjab.

Heard.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that co-accused has already been granted benefit of regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-3585-2018 vide order dated 8.2.2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the co-accused has already been granted bail and the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Avtar Singh alias Tari son of Gurtej

Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
