Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.174 dated 29.06.2017 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that in a similar matter bearing No.CRM-M- 8636-2017 (Jasvir Singh @ Shira Vs. State of Punjab), the petitioner has been granted anticipatory bail. Therefore, treating the case of the petitioner on the same parity, she may also be granted anticipatory bail.

Heard.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court within one week and shall be admitted to fresh bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
