The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 78 dated 11.08.2018, under Sections 452, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Batala.

The operative part of the order dated 18.09.2018, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the FIR has been registered on account of a dispute, which occurred due to playing of DJ on high volume. It is further submitted that no one was injured in the case and no MLR of any person was recorded.

Notice of motion for 25.10.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 18.09.2018, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the

petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 18.09.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
