Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.71 dated 27.05.2018, registered under Sections 323, 452, 506 of IPC and Sections 8/16 of POCSO Act, at Police Station Barara, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations were that Sushila, sister-in-law of the complainant, had given medicines and had forced her to have friendly relations with the petitioner and the allegations are that on 24.05.2018, the petitioner entered the house and molested the girl. Counsel submits that the petitioner is working as a sweeper in the village and father of the complainant is a Chowkidar and challan has been presented and the petitioner is married and it is not possible to enter the house at night when the whole family is present.

Investigation is over. Challan has been presented.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate with a condition that the petitioner would not contact the victim or her family.
