Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to register an FIR against respondents No.5 to 8 for committing murder of Pritpal Singh father of the petitioner.

Pursuant to order dated 05.10.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner Harshbir Singh is present in the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that Pritpal Singh father of the petitioner had died in mysterious circumstances and the petitioner came to know about the sudden death of his father on 12.07.2018. The petitioner approached the police authority for registration of a case, but still the FIR has not been registered.

Having recourse to the law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Sakiri Vasu Versus State of U.P. and others (2008) 2 SCC 409*, this Court finds that no such direction can be issued by this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. However, without commenting on the merits of the case, but noticing the fact that Pritpal Singh has died, may be natural or as alleged by the petitioner in representation dated 13.07.2018 (Annexure P-4) made to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the contents of said representation and to act in accordance with law.
