INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.95 dated 13.03.2002, registered at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, under Sections 332, 353, 186 and 295 of the Indian Penal Code (for brevity, 'IPC').

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, was registered on 13.03.2002, under Sections 332, 353, 186 and 295 of IPC and the present petitioner was declared proclaimed offender on 20.11.2009. Now, the present petitioner has filed this petition after a period of nine years of declaring him as proclaimed offender.

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Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
