Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.1243 dated 12.08.2017 under Section 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the order dated 03.11.2017, both the petitioners, who are father-in-law and mother-in-law of respondent No.2, have already joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation. It is further submitted that husband of respondent No.2, son of the petitioners, has committed suicide and the petitioners have given a complaint against respondent No.2-complainant at Gawalior, Madhya Pradesh and the matter is pending for investigation and as a counter-blast, present FIR has been registered.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rakesh Kumar, has submitted that the petitioners have already joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 03.11.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
