This is second regular bail application filed in case
FIR No.60 dated 22.04.2016 registered under Sections 21, 22, 27 and
29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Shambhu, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the
petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. He is in
custody since 22.04.2016.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel informs
that out of 19 prosecution witnesses, 18 have been examined whereas,
the examination-in-chief of the last PW has already been recorded.

Considering the fact that the trial is at the fag end, the
Court at this stage is not inclined to consider the case on merits.

Dismissed.

However, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 22.04.2016, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.
