Vakalatnama has been filed on behalf of the complainant and same is taken on record.

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.0091 dated 29.07.2018 registered under Sections 365, 366, 343, 376, 120-B, 506 IPC at Police Station Phase-11, SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 09.08.2018 and challan has been presented though charge has not been framed. Counsel contends that the complainant had got married to the petitioner and they had lived together for six days and the FIR was lodged on the 7th day and the complainant is alleging kidnapping, forcefull

marriage and rape.

Learned counsel for the complainant has appeared and states that a compromise has been effected.

Learned State counsel informs that complainant had made allegations that she had been sold and there was no matrimonial alliance.

Investigation is over. Challan has been presented.

The petitioner has placed on record the photographs to show that marriage ceremony was performed in the presence of her relatives.

The trial would take time, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court.
