The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, "Cr.P.C".) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.93 dated 9.4.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 279, 337, 304 and 302 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station 34, South, Chandigarh.

Heard.

Learned State counsel has submitted list of witnesses as well as photocopy of the statement of Ajay Kumar @ Raju.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that two witnesses namely Parmod Kumar and Vinod Kumar turned hostile and the petitioner is entitled to bail at this stage.

The trial is in progress. Out of the three eye witnesses, two have already been examined and one person namely Ajay Kumar @ Raju is yet to be examined.

To the mind of this Court, no case is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner as one eye witness namely Ajay Kumar @ Raju is yet to be examined.
