Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.171 dated 15.03.2017, under
Sections 302, 34, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959,
registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurugram.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel
has appeared and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is not
named in the FIR. However, there is no allegation against him regarding
his involvement in the murder. As per the allegations of the prosecution,

Deepak @ Dhola was driving the motor-cycle and Anshul had fired shots upon the deceased. The allegation against the present petitioner is that while he was in jail, he had introduced Manjeet Mahal with one Suresh @ Guddu, who provided the weapon of offence.

The petitioner has been in custody since 12.07.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
