The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.136 dated 27.07.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Kapurthala, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that investigation in this case is complete and the trial is in progress. However, the completion of the same is likely to take some time. The recovery effected from the petitioner is marginally higher than the commercial quantity and thus, regular bail be granted to him.

Custody certificate dated 30.04.2018, prepared by Iqbal Singh, PPS, Dy. Superintendent, Central Jail, Jalandhar, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual period of custody for one year and nine days. There is no other case under the NDPS Act, 1985, pending against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner-Rajwinder Singh @ Raja, is ordered to

be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
