Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.28 dated 02.02.2018, registered at Police Station Yamuna Nagar Sadar, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned

State counsel and gone through the record.

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As per the allegations in the FIR, an amount of ₹2,60,000/- was deposited by the complainant in the account of Amrit Pal on the instructions of accused persons. The present petitioner is named in the FIR. As per the FIR, the accused had taken money for sending complainant's brother to Italy. It is also mentioned in the FIR that the accused persons had also taken ₹1 lakh in cash from the complainant. Perusal of record shows that earlier also, there was another FIR registered against the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; serious allegations are against the present petitioner and that he is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
