Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for
issuance of a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to call the petitioner in
the office of respondent No.2 at the behest of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that respondent Nos.4
to 6 have already lodged many false cases against the petitioner and in all
these cases, petitioner has been acquitted but still she is being called again
in the office of respondent No.2.

Learned State Counsel has filed the status report by way of

Wing, Ludhiana and the same is taken on record.

As per said affidavit, petitioner is accused in as many as 13 cases, which are of similar nature.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from Inspector Ranjit Singh, who is present in the Court, states that the petitioner has collected money from various people on the pretext of sending them abroad and for this reason, the petitioner is required to be associated in the proceedings.

Considering the nature of allegations against the petitioner wherein as many as 13 FIRs have been registered against her, this Court finds that filing of the present petition is nothing but is an abuse of process of law. Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.

The A.I.G., NRI, Ludhiana, shall look into the FIRs so registered against the petitioner for fair investigation.
