Present second petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Vishal and Gautam @ Abhishek in case registered by way of FIR No. 266 dated 02.05.2015 at Police Station Sadar Karnal, under Sections 323, 325, 307, 365, 449, 506, 34 of IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners have duly complied with the order dated 16.11.2017 and have appeared before the trial Court and have been released on bail, which is not controverted by learned State counsel.
