The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.153, dated 11.07.2017, under Sections 308, 323 & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 09.08.2017. The trial may take time to conclude as defence evidence has not yet started. The maximum sentence which can be imposed upon the petitioner is RI for 03 years and he has already undergone incarceration of 01 year and 02 months and that regular bail be granted to him.

Learned State counsel submits that the prosecution evidence is complete and the trial is getting delayed because on the last three dates

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before the trial Court, the petitioner has failed to produce evidence in his defence.

The petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to conclude his defence evidence at the earliest so that the trial can be concluded.
