Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has since joined the investigation and has furnished an affidavit that the petitioner does not hold any passport.

Learned state counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, concede these facts, further stating that since the petitioner has joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected from her, therefore, she is not required by the local police for further investigation.

In these circumstances, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.11.2017 is made absolute, subject to

fulfillment of conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition in that way is allowed.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner is found to be indulging in any criminal activity, after being granted bail vide this order, the order shall be liable to be withdrawn.
