This is an application for amendment of the main petition as Section 467, 468, 471 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code were added later on after the investigation by the police.

Application is allowed. Amended petition is taken on record.

CRM-M-41478-2018

Petitioner-Pardeep Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.493 dated 21.4.2018, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar, in which offences under Sections 467, 468, 471 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code has been added during investigation.

It comes out that the case is pertaining to obtaining a loan by showing the property of respondent No. 2-Poonam Khurana to be the plot of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states at bar that plot of respondent No. 2 is different than the plot owned by him and he does not claim the ownership of the plot owned by respondent No. 2. Petitioner was arrested on 27.7.2018 and since then he is in custody.

Learned State counsel submits that in this case challan has been presented and charges have been framed.

It being so, there is no ground for further detention of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to following conditions: -

- (1) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
