The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.150 dated 19.05.2018, registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station A Division, Police Commissionerate, District Amritsar.

As per prosecution version, there was matrimonial discord between Gurmukh Singh (deceased) and Rajwant Kaur, and due to this, Gurmukh Singh committed suicide.

The petitioners are the mother-in-law and the brother in law (wife's brother) of the deceased.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from them and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 20.09.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
