Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 232 dated 20.10.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 452 and 506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner, on 17.10.2017, has caused five injuries to the complainant/victim Anita Rani who was preparing food in the kitchen of her house. A perusal of the FIR shows that petitioner, while entering into the house of the victim/complainant, carrying a *Datar* had caused injuries on the head and face of the victim.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector Dharminder Singh, submits that the petitioner is evading his arrest and as per the opinion of the doctor, one injury is caused by a sharp edged weapon which co-relates with the weapon of the petitioner i.e. a *Datar*.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, I find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner as the allegations levelled against the petitioner are of causing five injuries to the victim/complainant who was

preparing food in the kitchen of her own house.

In view of the above, without making any comment on the merits of the case, considering the serious allegations against the petitioner, this petition is dismissed.
