Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.103, dated 09.04.2016, under Sections 148/307/109/120-B/149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Rewari, District Rewari.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Shivam in relation to an alleged occurrence dated 09.04.2016. Allegations are that the complainant was assaulted by four persons, who had come on two separate motorcycles. Complainant identified three out of them, namely, Kalia @ Premwasi, Lallu @ Lalit and Monia.

As per prosecution version, co-accused Lallu had fired at the complainant with a country made pistol and the bullet hit on his right hip.

Name of the petitioner does not figure in the FIR.

Petitioner has been implicated on the statement of co-accused i.e. Kalia and Lallu. Petitioner was arrested on 28.07.2017.

Investigation qua the petitioner is complete and even challan stands presented and the trial is at the very initial stage.

The fire arm injury is specifically attributed to co-accused Lallu @ Lalit.

Without making any observations on merits and in view of the above, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Rewari.
