The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner-Jagtar Singh @ Kala @ Chamkila, in case FIR No.143 dated 11.09.2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 324, 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') at Police Station Nangal, District Roopnagar.

Heard.

The role attributed to the petitioner is to cause simple hurt with a rod on the head of the victim and further that he caught hold the victim and co-accused has given *kirch* blow in the abdomen of the victim. Petitioner is in custody since 07.10.2016.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
