The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail in FIR No.28 dated 17.01.2015, registered under Sections 302, 303, 120-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at P.S. Mahesh Nagar, District Ambala.

There is no assistance on behalf of the petitioner, however, it has been averred in the petition that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. He has been falsely implicated in the instant case on the basis of disclosure statements of co-accused Vikas @ Vicky and Saurab. Except the disclosure statements of the co-accused, there is no material to connect the petitioner with the crime alleged. Co-accused Neeru Garg, Mohit Garg @ Mangu, Gurmej Singh @ Happy, Dalel Singh @ Dellu, Saurabh Kumar, Aman Sharma @ Talli and Arvind Sharma @ Honey have already been admitted to regular bail. The material witnesses have already been examined. The petitioner is in custody since 17.01.2015.

This is the sixth bail petition filed by the petitioner. The offence alleged comes under the category of heinous crimes. He is involved in a large number of FIRs. No fresh favourable circumstance has been cited by the petitioner. The antecedents of the petitioner disentitle him to the relief sought. The trial is in progress. Once released on bail, there is every apprehension that the petitioner may influence the course of trial.

In view of the above, no case for grant of bail is made out.

Dismissed.
