GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.25 dated 23.3.2011 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 427 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Rampura, District Bathinda and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 20.9.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phul has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Surjit Singh, Amrik Singh, Amandeep Singh and Jaswinder Singh @ Jagsir Singh as well as of complainant Kuldeep Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter

amongst themselves. It has specifically been opined by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phul that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.25 dated 23.3.2011 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 427 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Rampura, District Bathinda and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
