In the light of the alleged recovery i.e. 19 kgs of opium, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner, at this stage.

Accordingly, the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to expedite the trial and in any case conclude the same within a period of four months from today.
