This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.0171, dated 29.06.2018, under Sections 398, 401 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Israna, District Panipat.

Heard.

Custody certificate of the petitioner has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he along with other co-accused was robbing the passers by. When the police party reached, the accused without knowing their identity tried to rob the police party also with the help of country made pistol. He along with co-accused was overpowered at the spot and a country made pistol was recovered from the petitioner and a knife was recovered from the co-accused.

As per custody certificate, the petitioner is in custody for the last two months, 28 days. However, he is accused in three other cases also. Out of which two are of theft. He has also been convicted in one case under Sections 379 and 411 IPC.

Considering the background of the petitioner, if the petitioner is released on bail, he is likely to commit similar offence. Therefore, there is no ground to release the petitioner on bail.

As such, the present petition is dismissed.
