GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seeks quashing of FIR No. 188 dated 28.04.2018, Police Station City Palwal, under Sections 379-B, 452, 506, 294, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 20.09.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Palwal so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Palwal has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Abhishek have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that the complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically stated by complainant that that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 188 dated 28.04.2018, Police Station City Palwal, under Sections 379-B, 452, 506, 294, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
