ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral):

Prayer in these petitions is for grant of regular bail to the
petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in
judicial custody since 12.10.2017; challan has already been presented and
charges were framed on 01.02.2018, however, till date, no prosecution

witness has been examined and conclusion of the trial will take some time.

Counsel further submit that the FIR was registered on a secret information and, thereafter, all the petitioners were arrested with the allegations that they are involved in a theft of vehicle and preparing forged and fake number plates and R.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh, however, has opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that one more FIR is pending against the petitioners, though, the petitioners are on bail in the said FIR, however, recovery of motorcycle/scooter was effected from them.

Without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioners are in judicial custody since 12.10.2017; they are not required for any further custodial investigation as challan has been presented and charges have been framed and in view of the fact that till date, no evidence has been recorded and the petitioners are on bail in another FIR, the petitiones are directed to be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, Duty Magistrate.
