It is alleged that complainant Naresh Kumar alongwith Gurcharan Singh was going to pay obeisance at Mata Naina Devi. Near temple of lower Jhinjri, near Bhakra Canal, two motorcycles came from behind. Four persons were riding said motorcycles. They were having rods, dandas and knives. On phone, they called 3-4 more persons. Co accused (petitioner) Dharamvir Singh alias Raja and Gurwinder Singh alias Kalu, who were armed with dandas, came there. It is alleged that Sukhwinder Singh alias Shinder gave a knife blow in the stomach of complainant. Co accused Dharamvir Singh alias Raja (petitioner) and Gurwinder Singh alias Kalu, gave kick blows on stomach and chest of complainant. Gurcharan Singh was also given beating. Allegations show that blows were given with intention to kill complainant in furtherance of common object of unlawful assembly. Therefore, all accused will be veraciously liable for same. The blows on stomach could prove fatal. It is not a case of undue hardship. No ground to grant anticipatory bail is made out. Petition is therefore dismissed.
