Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass or interfere in the married life of the petitioners at the instance of respondents No.4 to 7 and his other family members.

Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 in court today, is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition. He further states that petitioner No.1 has no objection in case custody of the petitioner No.2-

Pooja Rani is given to respondent Nos. 4 & 5, who are parents of petitioner No.2.

This Court vide order dated 20.09.2018 had sent the petitioner No.2 to Nari Niketan, Sector 26, Chandigarh and petitioner No.1 to Protection Home, Sector 19, Chandigarh.

Since the petitioners are withdrawing the present petition, Nari Niketan is directed to handover petitioner No.2-Pooja Rani to respondents No.4 and 5 who are parents of petitioner No.2. Similarly, petitioner No.1-Jaswant Singh is also directed to be released from the Protection Home, Sector 19, Chandigarh.

In view of above, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
