This is second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.67 dated 27.02.2018 registered under Section 379-A of IPC at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he has snatched a purse containing a phone, documents and cash of Rs.15,000/- from the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is in custody since 15.04.2018. He is a patient of HIV+.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh, states that there are number of FIRs registered against the petitioner. He has produced a list of such cases which is signed by ASI Bhupinder Singh, CIA-I Staff, Ambala City, dated 07.12.2018, which is taken on

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the number of cases so registered against the petitioner, this Court finds that the track record of the petitioner does not warrant him to be admitted on bail.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.

As regard the argument of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is a patient of HIV+, this fact has neither been pleaded in the petition nor any evidence has been brought on record.

If that be so, petitioner is at liberty to file a fresh petition after having proper documents.
