GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.2 dated 07.01.2015 under Sections 392, 411, 397 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Nurmehal, District Jalandhar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 20.02.2018 the parties had been directed to

appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar has been received to the effect that statements of complainant-Jagjit Singh and also of the petitioners/accused namely Lakhjit Singh, Gurvinder Singh @ Labha and Harvir Singh @ Hobbi have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter and that the complainant has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed. Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar has categorically opined that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without there being any coercion or pressure and with free consent of the parties.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.2 dated 07.01.2015 under Sections 392, 411, 397 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Nurmehal, District Jalandhar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
