In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0185 dated 18.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is in custody since 18.07.2018. Perusal of the file, it is evident that petitioner is not involved in any other case. The aforesaid issues have not been disputed by the learned State counsel.

- (i) Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
