Petitioner Deepak alias Bihari has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.239 dated 13.03.2018, registered at Police Station Hisar Sadar, District Hisar, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 147, 148, 452, 506 and 120-B of IPC, but later on during investigation, Section 326 of IPC has been added by the Investigating Agency.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the simple injury has been attributed to the present petitioner, whereas the grievous injury has been attributed to the co-accused.

The petitioner has been in custody since 13.08.2018. He is not

required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. The offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
