The petitioner is seeking permission to travel to the United States of America to visit his son and grand children. He is accused of having committed offence under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC and FIR No.85 dated 25.08.2014 has been registered in this regard at Police Station Sadar, Phagwara, District Kapurthala. Anticipatory bail has been granted to him vide order dated 11.03.2015 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.32021 of 2014, titled as 'Gurmit Singh Palahi Vs. State of Punjab'. Till date there is no report of any misuse of the concession of anticipatory bail by the petitioner.

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Having regard to the above facts, I deem it appropriate to permit the petitioner to travel to the United States of America to visit his son and grand children. Name and address of his son is as follows:-

California USA”*

Petitioner shall return not later than 15.05.2018 and report to the Police Station concerned immediately thereafter. The details of his whereabouts in United States of America i.e. address of his son and telephone numbers would be informed to the concerned Police Station before he leaves the country.

Further, the petitioner shall also execute a security bond by furnishing documents of his residential house by appearing before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala, to the satisfaction of the latter.

The petition is allowed in the afore mentioned terms.
