The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to objectively consider the representation dated 18.07.2018 (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is found necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
