The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners namely, Yashpal and Baljit Kaur, in case FIR No.31 dated 27.06.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 489-A, 489-B and 489-C of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') (Section 489-D IPC added later on) at Police Station Division No.1, District Pathankot.

Heard.

Recovery has already been effected from the petitioners. They are in custody since 30.06.2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.

- (b) In the event of their absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioners shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure their presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioners shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) They shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
