The case of the petitioner is that respondents No. 5 and 6 took money from him for sending his son abroad, but failed to do so. The police also did not register any FIR on his complaint and, thus, the private complaint has been filed before the concerned Court. On account of filing of the said complaint, respondents No. 5 and 6 are harassing the petitioner. They want him to withdraw the complaint. The police is helping them in their nefarious designs. Thus, the petitioner fears for his life and liberty.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. J.S. Walia, Sr. DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No. 4 to 6.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 15.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks

from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. It shall be ensured that no harm shall caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner.
