Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FIR was registered in April, 1999 and the petitioner went abroad in March, 1999. Counsel states that the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in the year 2000 and a petition was filed in the High Court and the proclamation order was quashed. Counsel refers to Annexure P-4. Counsel further states that the petitioner has been coming to India thereafter in 2007, 2014 and 2017 and he had gone back and he is still abroad. Petitioner did not join the proceedings.

Counsel states that the petitioner was never asked to join the proceedings or the investigation.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition.
