In this petition, the petitioner seeks bail in the proceedings arising out in cross case vide DDR No.32 dated 14.03.2017 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 341, 506 and 34 of the IPC in main FIR No.96 dated 13.10.2016 under Sections 367, 302, 324 and 506 of the IPC registered at Police Station Division No.1, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, after the impugned order passed against him by the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana on 20.12.2017. The petitioner was already on bail earlier and the case was committed to the Court of Sessions for trial. The date of appearance before the Sessions Court was fixed for 20.12.2017 but according to the petitioner, he mistakenly understood the same as being 20.01.2018. He, therefore, seeks an opportunity to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court and get fresh bail.

In view of the grounds made out in the petition, the matter is disposed off with a direction that the warrant issued against the petitioner shall remain stayed for one week from today. In the meantime, he may

surrender before the Ld. Trial Court and seeks fresh bail. This order shall automatically stand lapsed after the evening of 09.02.2018.
