The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the representations dated 29.01.2018 and 28.08.2018 to be decided expeditiously.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against the private respondents, who are the main persons involved. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representations should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Seena Mand, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representations of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks, on receipt

of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representations dated 29.01.2018 (Annexure P-2) and 28.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
