GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.96 dated 18.10.2017 under Sections 323, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station, District Kapurthala and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 01.11.2017 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements

recorded.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kapurthala has been received wherein it has been reported she has recorded the statements of complainant-Sandeep Kaur, injured-Harwinder Singh and also of the accused, who have all stated that the matter stands compromised amongst them. It has specifically been opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any threat, coercion or pressure and their compromise is genuine.

In view of the aforesaid report regarding the matter having been compromised and also in the light of ratio of Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.96 dated 18.10.2017 under Sections 323, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station, District Kapurthala and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
